National Music and Drill Competition 2020

With the ongoing lock-down, as with most events this year our Music and Drill competition has had to be cancelled. On the day,

Saturday 26th September 2020,

it is proposed to broadcast old Band displays, and feature solo and group musical displays from Companies who wish to be involved.

St Marks is going to be involved as we usually are!

At a recent meeting of Bandmasters, it was decided to run the following events with clips being released on the day:

- Solo (or single household) videos - Anyone from any company, any age, any instrument (or voice). Participant must be wearing either Brigade branded clothing (Hoodie, Shirt, uniform) or fancy dress appropriate for the piece of music. Nonstandard Brigade instruments to be encouraged. A certificate and feedback (from some of the normal judging panel) to be provided for all entries.
- A massed recording of a piece of music by any Brigade member wishing to take part. This will be The Little Bugler (Duthoit). Parts will be released as soon as possible alongside videos of individual parts and a video of the entire piece of music.
- Archive clips of previous National Band Competitions and National Music and Drill Competitions. (If you can start looking through your records). This would be good if they came with an explanation (either a video intro or some type to go with the clip on the day).

All submissions for the solo (or single household) videos and the massed recording will need to be submitted with a short permission form (completed by an over 18 if the member is under 18).

A link will be set up for videos (including your archive material) and permission forms to be uploaded too.
